

So you've scheduled a shoot with ShortStock or Electric Tiger Productions, now what?

1) Print this PDF for your reference or store it on your smart phone.

2) Make note of your shoot date and time (add it to your phone's calendar or reminder now). Arrive early as others are waiting for your and we can't start without you!

3) Make note of the location. How long will it take you to arrive in heavy traffic, construction, or you forget something and have to head back? These things happen and we understand, but **if it seems like there will be a delay, call immediately and let us know!** You can always call 520-360-8293 (cell) if you have any problems.

4) Please let us know if you CAN'T make it.

This isn't just a professional courtesy. When it's less than 3 days until the shoot, there are a number of things in place which make a no call/no show very frustrating and costly. Imagine planning a party and the guest of honor never shows up! Email, call or text as soon as there is an issue with the date and time:

5) We are trying to assess your abilities, look and a whole variety of factors. Especially what we can use you for in the future. We also want you to be relaxed, have fun, and be creative!

We know you're trying us out, too. A professional relationship doesn't happen overnight and a lot rides on a good one. **Let us know what we can do better.**

6) Bring driver's license, state issued ID or passport.

You will be signing paperwork and will need to show your ID. We will keep your information private. For nudes, you must bring 2 forms of photo ID.

7) What to wear: Unless otherwise specified, you will want the following types of clothes:

- Bring at least 3 different changes of clothes. Try to bring 3 different bottoms (ie: pants, shorts, skirts), 3 different tops and 3 different pairs of shoes.
- Bring a couple different types of shoes - a casual pair, a dressy pair, and high heels (for women).
- In hot weather, loose-fitting, breathable clothes are better. We want good footage, but we don't want you to pass out from heat!
- In cold weather, bring a jacket, hoodie or coat.
- Bring a broad-brimmed hat to cover your head, face, and/or the back of your neck.
- Sunburns really suck. We will have some sunscreen on hand, but if you need or use something particular, please bring that, too.
- Jeans, shorts, khakis, and solid colored clothing.

8) What NOT to bring:

- Avoid lots of whites, blacks, stripes, or checkered patterns unless otherwise stated.
- Please avoid "neon" or "fluorescent" colors unless specified. These wreak havoc with video sensors.
- Clothing cannot have any copyrighted, trademarked, or other graphics or writing. If you're not sure, please ask.

Why? These all require releases from their owners and we can get into a lot of trouble for using them. It seems silly, but it's a deal breaker for us: we can get in really big trouble for depicting someone else's intellectual property without their permission.

Remember to have fun, relax, and be creative!
